The Food Bank's **MOBILE FOOD BANK** program provides fresh fruits, vegetables and other healthy foods to individuals of all ages. Please bring a bag to fill for each distribution. No verifications are required.

The Food Bank's **BROWN BAG: FOOD FOR ELDER**s program provides healthy staples each month to qualifying seniors (over 55 years old). **An application and an annual renewal are required.** Please contact The Food Bank's Brown Bag Department for more information.

In addition, you may be eligible for **SNAP** (formerly known as "food stamps"), which provides cash for groceries for low-income individuals and families. To see if you qualify, please contact **The Food Bank of Western Massachusetts' SNAP Department at (413)992-6204**. Households that receive SNAP are also eligible for HIP, which provides extra money for fresh produce each month.
