The Food Bank's **MOBILE FOOD BANK** program provides fresh fruits, vegetables and other healthy foods to individuals of all ages. Please bring a bag to fill for each distribution. No verifications are required.

The Food Bank's **BROWN BAG: FOOD FOR ELDER**S program provides healthy staples each month to qualifying seniors (over 55 years old). An application and an annual renewal are required. Please contact The Food Bank's Brown Bag Department for more information.

In addition, you may be eligible for **SNAP** (formerly known as "food stamps"), which provides cash for groceries for low-income individuals and families. To see if you qualify, please contact **The Food Bank of Western Massachusetts' SNAP Department at (413)247-9738**. Households that receive SNAP are also eligible for HIP, which provides extra money for fresh produce each month.
